

How to Set Up Your iPad So Pages and Keynote Will Back Up to iCloud:

It is important to check these settings to ensure your Pages and Keynote are backed up in case something happens to your iPad.

Even if you are not using Pages or Keynote this semester, please take a few minutes to check your Settings. If you do not see Pages or Keynote listed in your Settings, this means the apps are not installed on your iPad. They are available for download in your App Store.

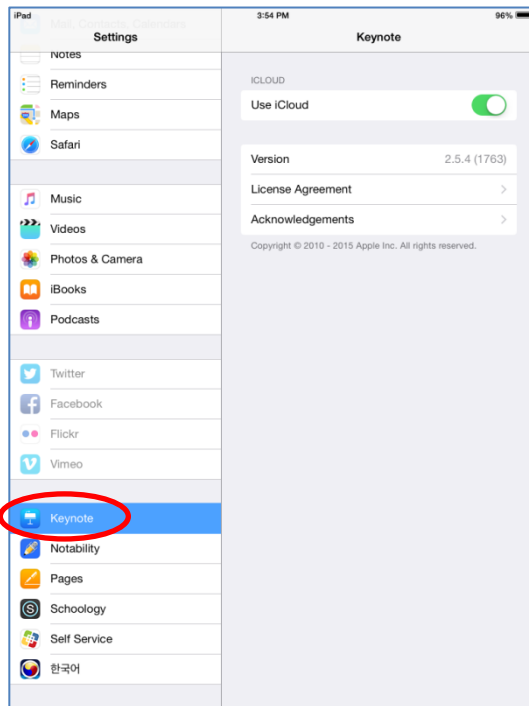
Once you have connected your iPad to a power source and Wi-Fi and locked your iPad screen, your iPad will back up to iCloud.

Keynote

1. Go to the Settings icon on your iPad.



2. Scroll down your Settings, and tap Keynote.



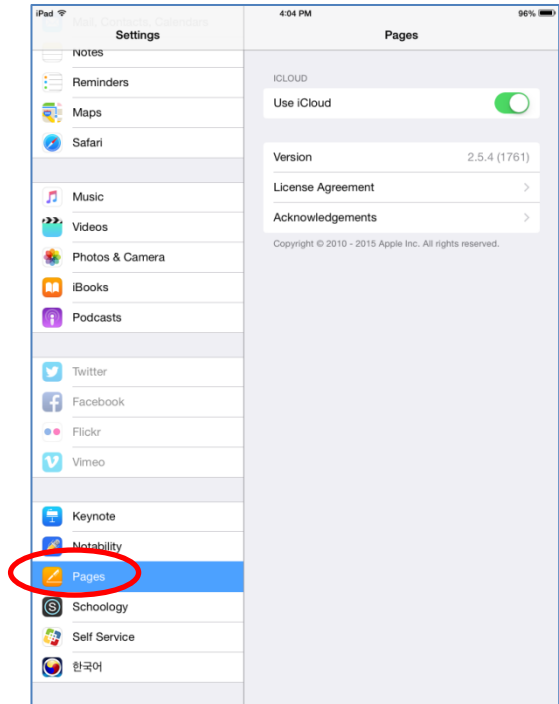
3. Move the "Use iCloud" button to the right to turn on iCloud for Keynote.

Pages

1. Go to the Settings icon on your iPad.



2. Scroll down your Settings, and tap Pages.



3. Move the "Use iCloud" button to the right to turn on iCloud for Pages.
